4	certified or otherwise regulated to provide health care services
5	under the laws of this Commonwealth.
6	"Health care services." Services for the diagnosis,
7	prevention, treatment, cure or relief of a health condition,
8	injury, disease or illness.
9	"Health insurance policy." As follows:
10	(1) An individual or group health insurance policy,
11	contract or plan that provides medical or health care
12	coverage by a health care facility or licensed health care
13	provider that is offered by or is governed under any of the
14	<pre>following:</pre>
15	(i) The act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known
16	as The Insurance Company Law of 1921.
17	(ii) The act of December 29, 1972 (P.L.1701,
18	No.364), known as the Health Maintenance Organization
19	Act.
20	(iii) Chapter 61 (relating to hospital plan
21	corporations).
22	(iv) Chapter 63 (relating to professional health
23	services plan corporations).
24	(2) The term does not include accident only, fixed
25	indemnity, limited benefit, credit, dental, vision, specified
26	disease, Medicare supplement, Civilian Health and Medical
27	Program of the Uniformed Services (CHAMPUS) supplement, long-
28	term care or disability income, workers' compensation or
29	automobile medical payment insurance.

"Telehealth." The remote interaction between a health care

4	(2) A computer video transmission.
5	(3) An electronic health monitoring device.
6	(4) Another telecommunications device that delivers
7	health information concerning a patient to a health care
8	professional.
9	§ 7102. Provision of coverage.
10	An insurer that issues, delivers, executes or renews a health
11	insurance policy in this Commonwealth shall provide coverage for
12	telehealth under the following conditions, as determined by the
13	patient's health care professional:
14	(1) The use of telehealth is appropriate for the
15	patient.
16	(2) The health care professional is able to maintain
17	proper direct examination of the patient or direct
18	examination of the patient is not necessary.
19	(3) The use of telehealth is expected to result in lower
20	health care costs than if it were not used.
21	§ 7103. Applicability.
22	This chapter applies as follows:
23	(1) If a rate or form is required to be filed with the
24	Federal Government or the department, this chapter applies to
25	a health insurance policy for which the rate or form is first
26	filed on or after the effective date of this chapter.
27	(2) If a rate or form is not required to be filed with
28	the Federal Government or the department, this chapter
29	applies to a health insurance policy issued or renewed on or
30	after 180 days after the effective date of this chapter.
